What information should the technical-construction documentation of an instrument include?

1. a description of:
 - a) construction and operation of the measuring instrument,
 - b) security features that ensure proper operation of the measuring instrument, if applicable,
 - c) control or adjustment devices, if applicable,
 - d) places on the measuring instruments assigned for placement of verification marks and sealing marks, if applicable;
2. overall drawings of the measuring instrument and, if necessary, the detailed structural drawings of basic elements, assemblies and circuits of the measuring instrument;
3. diagrams explaining the operation of the measuring instrument and, if necessary, photographs;
4. descriptions and explanations of drawings and diagrams;
5. software description, taking into account clear identification of the software version used and all the aspects of its security, if it is to be used.
